Andrews University AND Countryside Academy

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of students from high school occupational and/or Career and Technical Education (CTE) program to **Andrews University** from the Countryside Academy in the Berrien Country school district.

General Conditions & Requirements:

1. Students who complete the Countryside Academy Aviation course and pass the FAA Private Pilot Written Exam are eligible for 4 Andrews University credits as AFLT 115 Private Pilot Ground School.
2. Students may apply for articulated credit within two years of high school graduation, after completing at least one semester admitted to an Andrews University aviation program.
3. Students fill in the top of the Verification Form, (at andrews.edu/services/precollege/cte-verification-au.pdf) save and email to their school counselor, who emails to precollege@andrews.edu once completed.
