INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

Advance Payment: Applicants attending the main campus from outside the United States (except Bahamas, Bermuda, Canada & Mexico) must make an advance payment of \$9,100. No university scholarships may be applied to make this payment. \$3,000 of this payment will be held in an interest-bearing deposit account. The deposit plus interest is refunded when the student's enrollment is terminated. Alternatively, it can be used as partial payment for the final semester of registration. International students do not get a rebate when their deposit is used to pay tuition costs. \$100 of the advance payment will be posted to the student account to cover the non-refundable new student International fee. **NOTE:** Once you are no longer registered or it is your last semester and you owe a balance on any AU account, your International Deposit will be used to reduce or clear the balance.

Resource verification: Bank documentation as well as other forms of financial documentation are required to prove ability to support one's educational expenses. This documentation must be sent to the university directly from the bank. The applicant must demonstrate adequate financial support for the duration of the program for which (s)he is applying.

I-20 Form: Once the advance payment and resource verification are received and accepted, the university authorizes the International Student Services Office to issue the I-20 Form for the purpose of securing a United States student F-1 visa. Statement of Acknowledgement: The International Student Services Office provides this agreement by which the prospective student/sponsor commit themselves to maintaining a full study load as well as abiding by the INS rules and regulations. This signed statement is required and should be mailed with the application.

PAYMENT PLANS**3% REBATE PLAN***

*Rebate plans are not available for discounted, CIEP programs, Self-Paced, or ELI classes. Rebates may be requested during the current year only and will not be given for a prior school year.

Full-time students may choose to pay their estimated out-of-pocket expenses for the full year by August 15 to receive a 3% rebate. After making payment, email sfs@andrews.edu by the first day of class to request the 3% rebate. The student's minimum out-of-pocket expense must be at least \$1,000 to qualify for this plan. The rebate is not available for payments made after the first day of class. Cash withdrawals and refunds are not available. Approved rebates will be applied to the student account after the last day to add/drop a class during fall semester.

1% REBATE PLAN*

Full-time students may choose to pay their estimated out-of-pocket expenses in full for the semester and receive a 1% rebate. The student's minimum out-of-pocket expense must be at least \$500 to qualify for this plan. Each payment must be receipted by August 15 for Fall semester and December 15 for Spring semester. After making payment, email sfs@andrews.edu by the first day of class to request the 1% rebate. The rebate is not available for payments made after the first day of class. Approved rebates will be applied to the student account after the last day to add/drop a class during each semester.

MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

Arrange to make monthly payments toward estimated out-of-pocket expenses for the semester. This plan requires that the following conditions be met:

- All previous account balances must be paid in full.
- Sum of monthly payments not to exceed 45% of estimated out-of-pocket expenses for semester.
- Monthly payments are to zero the account by the end of the semester to which the plan applies.
- Payments received after 30 days will incur a late fee of \$25.
- A 1% carrying charge will be posted for an unpaid balance at the end of the month.
- Minimum balance for this plan is \$100 or higher.
